3. Pay for your purchases, prescriptions, or **FUEL** with the Card at any Dillons or Kwik Shop.
4. **CONTINUE TO RELOAD** your Card monthly, weekly, or each time you shop at Dillons or Kwik Shop; **DO NOT THROW AWAY** the Card.
