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## MORE AROUND THE PARISH

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### SOUPER BOWL 2014

The Christmas season often makes us think of gifts and giving. There tends to be an increase in the giving to those less fortunate than ourselves. Hunger unfortunately is not a seasonal need but continues year round. One project that helps the agencies provide the soup to those in need is the annual SOUPER BOWL COLLECTION. This year's goal is to collect 48,000 cans of soup to be divided between the Emergency Aid Food Bank, Salvation Army, Salina Rescue Mission, Ashby House and DVACK (Domestic Violence Association of Central Kansas). *With discount purchasing available to the Souper Bowl drive a \$25 cash donation purchases 65 cans of soup.*

The SOUPER BOWL COLLECTION occurs on the last two weekends of January and the Saturday before the Super Bowl. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in conjunction with St. Mary's Parish has been asked to staff collection points at the Dillon's store on Planet Ave.

Saturdays: January 18<sup>th</sup>, January 25<sup>th</sup>, and February 1, will need to be staffed from 10 am to 12 pm, 12pm to 2 pm, 2 pm to 4 pm, and 4pm to 6 pm.

Sundays: January 19<sup>th</sup> and January 25<sup>th</sup>, the collection times are 1pm to 3 pm and 3 pm to 5 pm.

This would be a good opportunity for an individual, family, or student needing service hours, to contribute to the needs of the community.
